Golf Courses

Those who are interested in playing a standard game should plan to reserve a tee time at one of Galveston's scenic courses.

Moody Gardens Golf Course

Galveston Country Club

<u>Galveston Country Club</u>, Texas' oldest country club, is located at 14228 Stewart Road and is open from Tuesday through Sunday. Although the on-site golf course is private, some vacation packages allow guests to play at the club, so make sure to check with your hotel concierge or rental agent.

Galveston Country Club offers several amenities beyond golf. There is a pool on site as well as two tennis courts, and breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served from Tuesday through Sunday, including takeout options.

Driving Ranges

Driving ranges cater to golfers who are short on time or just want to dedicate time to improving their swing. These facilities will typically allow you to purchase a bucket of balls and hit them one by one.
